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**Rumaila Operating Organisation Selects ISNetwork for
Contractor/Supplier Management**

LONDON, United Kingdom (8 August 2011) – ISN is pleased to announce the Rumaila Operating Organisation (ROO) has selected ISNetwork to enhance its contractor qualification process for its local Iraqi and overseas suppliers.

ROO is a consortium of companies including BP, PetroChina, the South Oil Company and the Iraq State Oil Marketing Organisation (SOMO) tasked to increase production from the Rumaila oilfield, near Basra in south Iraq. The consortium led by BP aims to nearly triple the Rumaila field's output, which would make it the world's second largest producing oilfield. By 2016, production of 2.85 million barrels a day will mean Rumaila will account for 3% of global oil production.

“Our expansion into the Middle East and our partnership with ROO is an important milestone in ISN's history. Our companies have spent a great deal of time collaborating to ensure a seamless transition for ROO and their contractors,” said ISN President, Joe Eastin. “With great anticipation we look forward to the success of the ROO implementation and continued progress in the Middle East.”
