ISNetwork Welcomes New Alaskan Data Providers

North Slope Training Cooperative (NSTC) provides employee training records to ISNetwork

DALLAS, Texas (January 27, 2010)— ISNetwork is pleased to announce that recent data sharing relationships have been established with Beacon OHSS and NMS Training Systems. Beacon and NMS will now be exporting North Slope Training Cooperative (NSTC) Unescorted “6-Pack” training data to ISN’s vendor management database, ISNetwork. Alaskan Owner Clients and contractors can now access and manage their NSTC training records within their ISNetwork subscriptions. “We believe in this initiative and are excited about the opportunity to incorporate NSTC training into ISNetwork as a part of an overall safety evaluation on Alaskan contractors,” said Brittany Boynton, Manager of ISN’s Upstream and Mining teams.

The NSTC is a collaborative effort between many Alaskan Owner Clients, including BP Exploration (Alaska) Inc., ConocoPhillips Alaska, Inc., and their alliance of contractor companies. The objective of this group is to develop and maintain standardized, high-quality health, safety and environmental training programs for their employee and contractor workforce. Individuals performing work for BP, ConocoPhillips and other participating Owner Clients in the Alaskan North Slope oil field are required to complete the basic NSTC 6-Pack course prior to arrival on the Slope. This development will streamline the documentation of completed training and minimize the need for duplicative training as the workforce moves between Owner Clients and/or contractor companies.

Overall feedback on this new layer of verified training tracking has been positive. Glenn Hutson, with BP Exploration (Alaska) Inc. stated, “We are happy that ISN and the Alaska-based training providers are working together to streamline the use of ISNetwork.”
