Dallas, TX, February 26, 2002 – ISN Software Corporation (ISN) announced today that the Consortium on Operator Qualifications (COOQs) has selected ISNetworld as its preferred record keeping system. COOQs was formed in 1999 to create an industry response to DOT regulations contained in 49 CFR Part 192 Subpart N And 49 CFR Part 195 Subpart G. Among other things, these regulations require that any person performing covered tasks on a DOT regulated pipeline prove qualification through an assessment method specified by the pipeline operator. A record of this proof of qualification must be maintained for at least 5 years. ISNetworld will create and maintain this record.
