



## SafeGulf Communication

### Gulf of Mexico Contractors Working with BP, ChevronTexaco, Shell or ExxonMobil:

The SafeGulf Advisory Group has selected ISN Software's online compliance database, ISNetworld ([www.isnetworld.com](http://www.isnetworld.com)), as the method for verifying an individual's SafeGulf credentials. All SafeGulf Accredited Training Centers will directly link SafeGulf training records into ISNetworld. Any employee going offshore will have his/her credentials verified at BP, ChevronTexaco, Shell, and/or ExxonMobil shore locations through ISNetworld. SafeGulf credentials are consistent, minimum Health, Safety and Environmental (HSE) training requirements for the contractor community.

Effective January 1, 2006, all contractors must fulfill the SafeGulf minimum HSE training requirements prior to working on operator premises in the Gulf of Mexico. Details on database management are still being developed but the key elements are:

- All contractors must provide verification of minimum training as described under SafeGulf (additional specialized skills training may still be necessary) effective January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2006.

### Database Components

- The SafeGulf database will be managed by ISNetworld at no additional cost to data providers. A data provider is any third party SafeGulf Accredited Training Center. Training centers can be accredited through ASC, IADC or PEC/Premier.
- For contractors that have accredited in-house training and ARE NOT currently members of ISNetworld, there are two options, subscribe to ISNetworld, or enter your employee data through approved organizations such as ASC, IADC or PEC/Premier.

### Verification Components

- For current ISNetworld users, individual companies may choose to receive an ISN picture ID card compatible with SafeGulf for their employees at no additional cost. Or, they may choose the non-ISNetworld user option listed below.
- For non ISNetworld users, an identification medium such as a barcode will be provided by your accredited training center as per ISNetworld protocols.



BP, ChevronTexaco, Shell and ExxonMobil consider the new requirements a step in the right direction to ensure level playing field and a standard program for quality HSE training and knowledge retention of those contractor personnel that perform work on operator property.
