BMS Use of ISN Beters Safety and Insurance Compliance

Dallas, TX, November 20, 2008 – Prior to Bristol-Myers Squibb Company (BMS) subscribing to ISNetworld (ISN) their internal process was paper intensive. Additionally, prequalification evaluations were limited by manpower and only performed every three years.
