## ISN Implements Harmonised HSE Desktop Audit Protocols in Australia

The <u>Model Work Health and</u> <u>Safety (WHS) Act</u> is the result of this comprehensive national review and consolidation of work health and safety laws across Australia.

In line with the harmonisation of the legislation across states and territories, ISN has developed new safety program protocols used as part of its desktop audit services. These protocols went into effect in February 2012 and replaced state-based protocols for New South Wales, Queensland, the Australian Capital Territory and Northern Territory.
